National Merit Scholarship

Congratulations to Tess Bainbridge on becoming a National Merit Scholarship finalist. Earning this prestigious distinction involves a rigorous application process.



Tess Bainbridge

Students enter the National Merit Scholarship program when they take the PSAT/NMSQT® in the fall of their junior year. In September 2021, Tess was one of more than 16,000 Semifinalists designated on a state-representational basis in numbers proportional to each state's percentage of the national total of graduating high school seniors. Semifinalists were the highest-scoring program entrants in each state and represented less than one percent of the nation's seniors.

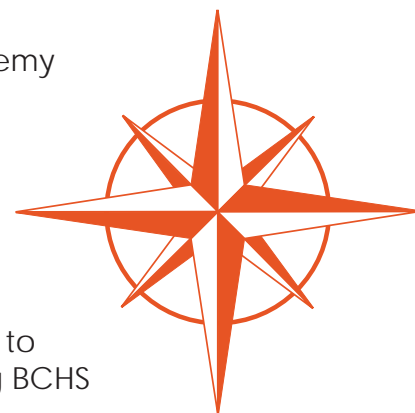
To be considered for a National Merit Scholarship, Semifinalists had to fulfill requirements to advance to Finalist standing. Each Semifinalist completed a detailed scholarship application, providing information about extracurricular activities and leadership positions. Semifinalists had to have an outstanding academic record, be endorsed and recommended by a high school official, and earn SAT® and ACT® scores. From the Semifinalist group, over 15,000 met Finalist requirements.

By the conclusion of the 2022 competition, about 7,500 Finalists received National Merit Scholarships totaling nearly \$28 million. Winners are the Finalist candidates judged to have the strongest combination of academic skills and achievements, extracurricular accomplishments, and potential for success in rigorous college studies.

North Star Academy

Congratulations to the 30 seniors who graduated from our North Star Academy this year! This was our 14th graduating class. The North Star Academy staff, along with Byron Center Public Schools, is dedicated to model leadership through passion, relevance, relationships, and high standards while seeking an alternative teaching approach. They are committed to providing appropriate support while building students of character who can excel in critical thinking, social awareness, problem-solving, and employability skills.

The personalized, blended-education program at Byron Center is designed to prepare students for their individual plan after high school while completing BCPS graduation requirements and receiving a BCPS diploma.



KCTC

Kent Career Tech Center offers education focusing on career exploration, career preparation, and continuing education leading to successful employment. Students who participate in a one or two year program receive high school credits, and in some cases, students may earn college credit.

These 46 BCHS seniors have earned industry-recognized certifications in the KCTC program. Some of these students will go on to receive additional training, while others are ready to enter the workforce. Congratulations, seniors!
