# Students Returning to the Building from 1st & 3rd Session KCTC

Students will have a chance to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program and other awards. The test is optional and free of charge. All juniors will still take the SAT in the spring. #### **Medication Reminders**

Just a few quick reminders regarding medications at BCPS...

- 1. Students may NOT carry any medications (prescription OR over the counter) on their persons with the exception of <u>approved</u> emergency medications.
- 2. BCPS does NOT provide stock medications such as tylenol, ibuprofen, etc. You must provide these for your students if needed.
- 3. ALL medications must be delivered by a parent/guardian to the main office/school nurse and must include a signed medication consent form (\*\*INCLUDE LINK HERE)
- 4. All medications must be in their original container and clearly labeled with student name, DOB, and dosage instructions. We cannot accept expired meds or meds in baggies/envelopes/etc.
- 5. OTC medications require parent signature only and PRESCRIPTION medications require both parent AND authorized physicians signature.
