

# FAQ: Senior All Night Party for High School Students

Everything Parents Need to Know

## What is a Senior All Night Party?

A Senior All Night Party is an event to celebrate the graduation of the senior students. It is a supervised, alcohol-free, and drug-free event that takes place immediately after the graduation ceremony and lasts throughout the night. The primary purpose of the Senior All Night Party is to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for graduates to celebrate their accomplishments with their peers in a fun and safe environment. With the support and involvement of parents, school staff, and the community, the event promises to be a memorable conclusion to the high school experience.

## Who Organizes the Party?

The party is organized by a committee of parents who work together to plan and coordinate the event. They ensure that the venue, entertainment, food, and security are all arranged to create a memorable experience for the graduates.

## Where is the Party Held?

The location of the party is secret until graduation night. Common venues include college gymnasiums, recreational centers, or rented facilities such as amusement parks or bowling alleys.

## What Activities are Available at the Party?

The party features a variety of entertainment options to keep students engaged throughout the night. Following are examples of past year activities that may or may not be included:

- Music
- Games and competitions
- Photo booths
- Inflatable attractions
- Prizes and giveaways

## Is the Party Safe?

Yes, the safety of the students is a top priority. The event is supervised by chaperones, security personnel, and volunteers to ensure a secure environment. Additionally, the venue is locked down for the duration of the party, and students are not allowed to leave and re-enter.

## How do the students get to the venue for the Party?

There will be some time for family pictures after graduation and the students will be assigned a bus number to board at Calvin University directly following graduation. Chaperone volunteers will have a list of students to check in on the bus and will also ride the bus to the venue with them.

## What is the time of the Party?

The students will board the bus by 9:30 pm at Calvin University directly following graduation and be returned to the Byron Center High School by 5 am.

## What should the students wear to the Party?

The students should change into comfortable clothes and tennis shoes before boarding the bus.

## What Should Students Bring to the Party?

Nothing! Phones are not allowed and will be collected on the bus and returned on the bus ride back to the high school in the morning.

## Can we leave my student vehicle at the high school so they may drive home after the party?

Due to safety concerns of the students being up all night, someone must be at the high school at 5 am on Friday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, to pick them up.

## How Can Parents Get Involved?

Parents can get involved by volunteering their time to help set up, chaperone the event, and/or by contributing donations or supplies. Parent involvement is crucial to the success of the party and ensures that it is a memorable and safe celebration for all graduates. The committee will be sending the Volunteer sign up via email through school communications and the committee email.

## What if my student needs to leave early?

## What if I need to get ahold of my student during the party?

The committee will provide emergency contact information for use during the party.

## Can Students Leave the Party Early on their own?

For safety reasons, students are not allowed to leave the party early. If a student needs to leave due to an emergency, a parent or guardian must be contacted, and appropriate arrangements will be made by the event coordinators.
