Labor Day No School

Just a reminder, there will be <u>NO SCHOOL</u> on Friday, August 29, 2025 and Monday, September 1, 2025 in observance of the Labor Day holiday. Enjoy this time with your family! School will resume Tuesday, September 2, 2025.

Drop Off and Pick Up

Morning drop off is 8:20am. There will be no adult supervision prior to 8:20am.

The end of day pick up will be a learning process for our students. Please be patient as we get these processes running smoothly. A few reminders about pick up at the end of the day:

- <u>PINK SHEETS</u>: (You would have received it at our open house) Please have your pink sheets placed on your vehicle's dash or have your ID ready. You will receive one copy of the pick-up pink sheets. <u>It can be cut in half</u>. If you need another copy of the pink sheet, please let the office know.
- Students will enter vehicles on the sidewalk side ONLY (passenger side of your vehicle). Students should not go around to the other side for safety reasons.
- If you have to buckle a student into a car seat, please move forward to the area by the loading dock to do so.
- Please do not park your car and come into the building to pick up your child. Please stay in your car and stay in line.

Late Drop Off/ Early Pick Up

If your child must leave school during the school day, it is the policy for BCPS that each child has a parent sign them out in the office. If your child will be returning before the end of the school day, the parent must sign the student back in upon their return.

School Breakfast/Lunch

If you are in need of a free or reduced cost student lunch, please complete this Free/Reduced Form and return it to the school office. Snapcode

For all returning Marshall students: You should have received a "snapcode" letter with your placement information in the mail. (This letter was folded with your student's placement letter) Please take a couple minutes to log into the website given (your student's code will be noted in that letter) and update your contact information. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the school office.

Attendance

If your child will be absent, please email the school office meattendance@bcpsk12.net or call Marshall's attendance line (616) 878-6304 before 8:30am with the following information:

- Student's full name (first and last name)
- Teacher's name
- The reason for the absence. If your child is sick, please include the symptoms your student has. We are required to report to the Health Department weekly.
- Full name of the person reporting the absence and their relationship to the student.

If your child is coming to school late:

• If a student arrives after the 8:30am start time, they will be considered tardy and the parent <u>must</u> park their vehicle in the designated spot and bring the student into the office and sign them in.

If your child will be picked up early:

• Please contact the school office before 3:00pm to ensure we have enough time to communicate with your student's teacher.


Volunteering at Marshall

Student Medication

If your child is to take any over the counter medication at school, please print this <u>Medical</u> <u>Consent Form</u> and bring it to the school office.

Any prescription medication must have the Marshall Medication Consent Form filled out by the parent/guardian and Doctor before medication can be administered at school. We will also need a copy of the Doctor's Action Plan for each prescription medication.

Medications of any kind may not be kept in lockers, desks or backpacks. All medication (including over the counter meds and cough drops) must be brought to school by the parent/guardian. As required by state law, no medication can be transported on the school bus.

All medication should be in original packaging or in a prescription bottle with your child's name, medication name and dosage instructions clearly labeled.
