# **Labor Day No School**

## **Drop Off and Pick Up**

As a reminder, please use our drop off circle in the morning when bringing students to school. We ask that you do not park and walk students across the lot as it slows down the drop off process and causes unnecessary backups on 64th Street. In addition, please try to pull up to the second set of doors (marked Door #2) to allow more families to drop.

In the event that your child has something too large for them to carry and needs assistance, you may park and help them. If this is the case, please only use the designated crosswalk location to ensure safety.

Morning drop off is 8:20am. There will be no adult supervision prior to 8:20am.

The end of day pick up will be a learning process for our students. Please be patient as we get these processes running smoothly. A few reminders about pick up at the end of the day:

- PINK SHEETS: Please have your pink sheets placed on your vehicle's dash or have your ID ready. You will receive one copy of the pick-up pink sheets. It can be cut in half. If you need another copy of the pink sheet, please let the office know.
- If you have to buckle a student into a car seat, please move forward to the area by the loading dock to do so.
- Please do not park your car and come into the building to pick up your child. Please stay in your car and stay in line.

### **Attendance**

If your child will be absent, please email the school office <a href="mailto:meattendance@bcpsk12.net">meattendance@bcpsk12.net</a> or call Marshall's attendance line (616) 878-6304 before 8:30am with the following information:

- Student's full name (first and last name)
- Teacher's name
- The reason for the absence. If your child is sick, please include the symptoms your student has. We are required to report to the Health Department weekly.
- Full name of the person reporting the absence and their relationship to the student.

### If your child is coming to school late:

• If a student arrives after the 8:30am start time, they will be considered tardy and the parent <u>must</u> park their vehicle in the designated spot and bring the student into the office and sign them in.

#### If your child will be picked up early:

• Please contact the school office before 3:00pm to ensure we have enough time to communicate with your student's teacher.

### **Student Medication**

If your child is to take any over the counter medication at school, please print this <u>Medication</u> <u>Consent form</u> and bring it to the school office.

Any prescription medication must have the Marshall Medication Consent Form filled out by the parent/guardian and Doctor before medication can be administered at school. We will also need a copy of the Doctor's Action Plan for each prescription medication.

Medications of any kind may not be kept in lockers, desks or backpacks. All medication must be brought to school by the parent/guardian. As required by state law, <u>no medication can be transported on the school bus</u>.

All medication should be in original packaging or in a prescription bottle with your child's name, medication name and dosage instructions clearly labeled.
