Kindergarten Enrollment is OPEN

Children who will be turning five by September 1, 2025, can be registered for the 2025-2026 school year. Please use the online registration on the district website: Enrollment. To be fully enrolled, you need to bring your supporting documentation to the Administration offices to complete the process. After full registration is complete you will be contacted by your assigned elementary school to set up a date/time for kindergarten screening.

- Be on Time- Plan to arrive a little early. Teacher's work hard to stick to the 15 minute time allotted, so arriving and leaving on-time keeps everyone on schedule.
- Be a Team- Partnering with your child's teacher helps you both to provide consistent support for your child.
- Prepare Questions in Advance- Coming with specific questions will help make the most of your time together.

- Keep Teachers Informed- Let your child's teacher know about any situation at home that may affect your child's school work (such as a death in the family, a new baby, or a change in daycare arrangements, etc.)
- Take Notes & Leave with a Plan- Taking notes will help you remember what was discussed and what was agreed upon.
