Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held on **Tuesday, February 25**, from 5:00-8:00 pm and **Thursday, February 27**, from 1:00-4:00 pm and 5:00-8:00 pm. **Thursday, February 27 is a half day** of school, 12:00 pm dismissal. We look forward to this time to discuss your student's progress with you. Here are some helpful hints for a successful conference:

- Be on Time- Plan to arrive a little early. Teacher's work hard to stick to the 15 minute time allotted, so arriving and leaving on-time keeps everyone on schedule.
- Be a Team- Partnering with your child's teacher helps you both to provide consistent support for your child.
- Prepare Questions in Advance- Coming with specific questions will help make the most of your time together.
- Keep Teachers Informed- Let your child's teacher know about any situation at home that may affect your child's school work (such as a death in the family, a new baby, or a change in daycare arrangements, etc.)
- Take Notes & Leave with a Plan- Taking notes will help you remember what was discussed and what was agreed upon.
