**64th Street Road Closure**

**64th Street will be closed**

**Friday, September 4-18, 2026**

You will not be able to drive Eastbound on 64th from Byron Center Avenue. You will have to come to Marshall from Burlingame Avenue. Please know bus schedules will also be affected, buses may be late due to averted traffic and rerouting.

**AM Drop-Off:** A single line of cars at morning drop-off has been going well, we will keep that the same. **Please do not exit your vehicle in the drop off line to assist your child. Please park in the parking lot and use the crosswalk if your child needs assistance.**

- **Overflow:** If you are backed up on the road, please enter the parking lot and park in the far west row of parking spots (closest to the construction) and wait to merge into the drop-off line. Please do not exit your car. We need everyone off the street in an effort to keep traffic flowing.

**PM Pick-Up:** Please create a double line of cars for pick-up, stopping at the crosswalk for our loading zone. We were glad to have 2 days of practice before the closure.

- **Overflow:** If you are backed up on the road, please enter the parking lot and park in the far west row of parking spots (closest to the construction) and wait to merge into the pick-up line. Please do not exit your car. We need everyone off the street in an effort to keep traffic flowing.
