PM Pick-Up: 2 lanes at Pick-up will remain. Please create a double line of cars for pick-up, stopping at the crosswalk for our loading zone. Please return to our normal arrival procedure, coming from Byron Center Avenue (Eastbound) onto 64th Street to avoid turning left into the parking lot and blocking the road.

Please Review Pick-Up Overflow: If you are backed up on the road, please enter the parking lot and park in the far west row of parking spots (closest to the construction) and wait to merge into the pick-up line. Overflow into the parking lot is an effort to get cars off 64th Street and keep everyone safe. Please do not exit your car. We need everyone off the street in an effort to keep traffic flowing and keep everyone safe.
