#### B.E.S.T. (Bulldog Enhancement & Support Time)

B.E.S.T is a supervised opportunity to work on homework, study, or read before school, Monday - Thursday from 7:30 am - 7:50 am. Any and all students are welcome to attend.

#### **FLEX Days**

Starting Tuesday, September 16, we will have FLEX every Tuesday and Thursday. FLEX is a time built into the school day for teachers to provide remediation and intervention to students based on classroom data. Students are allowed to sign up to see a teacher from whom they need help and teachers will request students based on need. There will also be extension opportunities available as the year progresses. Any student who is not assigned to a specific teacher is in the gym or cafeteria reading silently. FLEX is an important and helpful time for both teachers and students. We will be taking time on Tuesday to explain FLEX to all students before jumping in on Thursday.
