
We all know and love Valentine's Day and the traditions we have in the United States, but have you ever wondered what some of the different traditions of Valentine's Day are in different countries? If so, you have come to the right place. Today, we will be looking at Valentine's Day traditions from different countries, such as the United Kingdom, Mexico, and Japan.

First, we are going to look at Valentine's Day in the UK. The UK has very similar traditions to the United States; likewise the most popular traditions contain giving, cards, chocolate, and flowers. The cards, whether anonymous or labeled with a name, are usually given to a partner, crush, or friend to show that you like and appreciate them. The chocolate normally comes in a box with multiple different types of chocolate. The flowers that are most commonly used are roses. Roses are a universal symbol of love and relationships.



Second, we are going to look at Valentine's Day in Mexico. Unlike the United States, Valentine's Day, also known as *El Día del Amor y la Amistad* in Spanish, in Mexico, Valentine's Day is not totally centered around being in relationships but instead spending time with your family. But there are still traditions for relationships as well. They often celebrate with a mariachi (A type of band). They often pay the band to play specific instruments or specific songs. People in Mexico also often take their loved ones to fancy restaurants. For the school children, like in the U.S., they exchange cards and treats, but unlike in the U.S., they also give out balloons.

Lastly, we are going to look at Valentine's Day in Japan. On Valentines Day or バレンタインデー, in Japanese, Instead of men traditionally giving chocolates to women, women give chocolates to men. Chocolate, often called Honmei-choco, is normally given to a husband, boyfriend, or partner, is normally homemade and expensive. Giri-choco is a type of chocolate often given to friends, relatives, and colleagues. They are



always cheap store-bought chocolates. On March 14, men often give gifts to women, like expensive white chocolate and jewelry.

In conclusion, Valentine's traditions vary from country to country, and each tradition is unique and special, and no two countries have the exact same traditions. So when Valentine's Day rolls around this year, think about how you might be celebrating something completely different from someone on the other side of the world.


This year's mascots Tina and Millo will also be there. Tina is short for Crocina and Millo is short for Milan, the
